14th anniversary of 9-11

America had a moment of silence for the 14th anniversary of the terrorist attack on 9-11. On September 11, 2001, at 8:46, the first plane hit, then at 9:03 the second plane hit the Twin Towers got attacked. Then, at 9:59 a.m. and 10:26 a.m. the Twin Towers crashed down. The Pentagon was also attacked that day, killing 184 people, including the 54 on board and 5 hijackers. Lastly, there was a fourth hijacked plane that crashed in a field in Pennsylvania, killing the 48 people on board, including 4 hijackers. Every year we have a moment of silence to honor the ones who died.

2,996 people were killed that day, including the 19 who hijacked the four planes. It was the deadliest day for New York city firefighters and civilians: 343 fireman died and 2,606 civilians died. It was the most deaths ever in America in one attack, almost 500 more than Pearl Harbor.

They now have a memorial/ museum to visit called the One World Trade Center. The new building is the tallest building in the Western Hemisphere, standing at a whopping 1,776 feet tall.

The people that had been blamed for this atrocity are the al-Qaeda group, and their leader, Osama bin Laden. On May 2, 2011, the U.S. military conducted a mission to execute Bin Laden, and found him in his house and killed him in Pakistan.
